

My father was a teacher. After serving in WW II, he held a series of jobs (car mechanic, gas station owner, oil truck driver). In his mid-40s, he convened a family meeting, announcing he wanted to go to college to become a math teacher. After quickly learning he had been away from math for too many years, he studied elementary

education instead. Then he taught 5th and 6th grades, later becoming a principal.

My sister also became an elementary school teacher. She married a teacher, the child of two teachers. Meg studied elementary education and taught outdoor education. I studied secondary education (math, like my dad), but also (like dad and Meg) ended up teaching in a different subject area.

Perhaps that is why, as our religious education starts up again this fall, and as we celebrate the 50th anniversary of the congregation's preschool program, I found myself turning to this prayer, written by a pastoral colleague (and one of my best friends in school) now serving in North Carolina:

God of Love... Thank you for every teacher who notices a child's special gift. Thank you for teachers who are listeners and gentle guides. Thank you for teachers who expect much and love enough to demand more. Thank you for the special teacher each one of us remembers.

God of Mercy... Sustain teachers who give everything they have and feel abandoned when society expects too much. Strengthen teachers who assume the blame for so many problems beyond their control. Help exhausted teachers rest.

God of Strength... Encourage teachers to care and inspire them to nourish. Motivate teachers to keep on learning for the fun of it and to make learning fun for children. We wonder at teachers who know how to quiet a class of five-year-olds or help fourth graders be empathetic. We admire teachers who enjoy middle school, or teach physics or math or civics. We cannot even imagine how to help every single student achieve Adequate Yearly Progress. Bless the people who are expected to accomplish these miracles and who know how to comfort children when miracles don't happen.

God of Justice... Help our nation find a way to steward our vast wealth to support teachers in their special calling, wherever they teach and whatever the race or religion or gender or wealth of the children.

We pray these things in the name of our great teacher, Jesus Christ. Amen.




Also, games and fun to be had for young and not so young participants, so bring your party animal!


