

Did you know The Federated Church was a community leader in providing housing for the homeless? Dale Beaman, Pastor Emeritus, was instrumental in starting PADS, a program where individuals moved <u>nightly</u> with their family and belongings from church to church. After this small beginning and much fundraising a permanent facility, Hope Haven, was built in DeKalb. Hope Haven provides shelter for homeless individuals and families with the goal of helping them to live in their own home.






The Federated Preschool's annual Cookie and Candy Sale will be Friday, December 14, 2018 beginning at 10:30 a.m.!


