For the Rev. Eric Ogi, who heard and accepted the call to serve as Federated Church's next settled Pastor and Teacher; and

For the Search Committee, which practiced patience, persistence, and prayer until it became clear that Rev. Ogi is the one who possesses the gifts and skills Federated Church needs at this moment in its ministry and mission, and that it is God's will that he be called to serve here.

Now we enter the final stage of the interim period, devoted to transitioning smoothly from my leadership to his. To that end, Rev. Ogi has asked that I remain on staff through Sunday, September 15th, during which time our ministries shall overlap. My primary responsibility will be to support him; to share with him what I have learned about this wonderful congregation and its potential; to catch him up on what we have accomplished, what is in process, and what remains unfinished that he might wish to address; to help introduce him and establish connections with the Association and Region; to gather helpful resources regarding the community of Sycamore for him; and, most importantly, to free him from other duties so that he can devote the first weeks of his ministry here to the critically important work of building pastoral relations with all of you.


The Church Council has authorized the naming of a transition team to help develop opportunities for Rev. Ogi to engage in small group conversations with Federated Church's members and friends, to learn more about the Sycamore community, and to be an additional group with which he can ask questions and find insight into Federated Church's history and values, hope and frustrations, resources and needs. To help ensure a heathy relationship for years to come, the Church Council also has agreed to take up the question of how to build a truly effective Pastor-Parish Relations Committee.

Your most important task during this last interim stage is to shift from thinking of me as your Pastor and Teacher to embracing Rev. Ogi's leadership and ministry. This period of overlapping is unusual in both the UUA and the UCC. It is happening at Rev. Ogi's suggestion and invitation, with the Associate Conference Minister's blessing, with the Search Committee's encouragement, and with the Church Council's approval. No doubt, Eric and I will work together as colleagues, equally committed to serving Federated Church's needs as best we are able. At the same time, upon his arrival, my role shall become secondary and will gradually diminish so that his ministry among you can increase and flourish.

Know that both Meg and I look forward to Eric and Shrestha's arrival with great joy. This is the call -- the answer to prayer -- for which you have been preparing for the last two years. We join you in saying "THANKS BE TO GOD!"
