From the Pastor's Desk

February is a month of transition. As the days slowly grow longer, we journey through Epiphany celebrating the Light of the World that shines in every darkness of life, and reflecting on what it means to actually follow this light in our own lives.

And then, just when the story climaxes and the light shines the brightest—just when we begin to feel spring trying to push through the snow—we enter the season of Lent. Beginning with Ash Wednesday (Feb 26th), we turn our attention to the humble reminder of our mortality: "from dust you came, to dust you shall return."

From light to dust. And only then to the light and Alleluia of Easter.

This is the profound paradox at the center of our faith: The way up is down.

As we transition from Epiphany to Lent, I invite you to consider how you will offer yourself to this journey. One opportunity will, of course, be joining us for a special Ash Wednesday service (more details to come). Another opportunity is to participate in a new faith formation series: over the course of six weeks, we will read and discuss Falling Upward: A Spirituality for the Two Halves of Life by Richard Rohr. (see flyer on p. 3 for more details).

Mirroring the transition we make from Epiphany to Lent—from light to dust—the book discusses how, in the first half of life, we are naturally and rightly preoccupied with establishing our identity—climbing, achieving, and performing. But those concerns will not serve us if we to embark on a further journey of meaning and purpose. Drawing on the wisdom from time-honored myths, heroic poems, great thinkers, and sacred religious texts, Rohr will help us explore the two halves of life to show that it is only those who have fallen, failed, or "gone down," who understand "up."


As we journey toward Easter and the promise of new life, I believe that conversations like these—with more to come in the future—will hold transformational power not only for us as individuals, but for our entire church!


